<p>3</p>	<p>Updates</p> <p><u>NHSE/I Framework for Integrated Care – EOI</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – CR discussed the update given at the last meeting regarding the EOI around trauma informed and responsiveness – £4.7m over three years, commitment that they will continue to fund up to 2030 – One successful ICS – competitive bid – CR and EI looked over the EOI which aligns with our ambition of being trauma informed and responsive by 2030 – Areas that more information is needed from each place – working with place leads specifically on priorities in year 1 and year 2, and how we will use the funding – Having a look at any consistent gaps to do some system wide work – First draft by 23rd June – go to strategy board on 30th for comment and feedback – Time until 15th July to refine – Will help to develop our ambition <p><u>Home Office Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – EI – update on home office funding – through VRU – 3 pots of funding around resilience training – put in bid for £619,000 – to establish a West Yorkshire ATR training collaborative – use resource we already have in our system – look at how we can develop bespoke offers of training – Looked at starting the training with police and housing – Bid will train in the first year 2,500 colleagues, put into uni degree for police degree, all housing staff from call handlers to wellbeing teams etc – Housing 3000 staff, police 2500 – cohort of total staff = 5500. – Put out to tender for a delivery partner to help us establish and deliver this training (training partner from West Yorkshire) in order to be self-sustaining – Find out on 25th June, Only two VRUs will be successful, Bid can be shared with members – Also, to develop a training matrix and competency network – opportunity to develop in house training so we don't have to charge – Establishment of peer support networks – Worked with health and housing lead Sarah Roxby, and Chris Gibson who leads on training for the police, leads of housing associations signed up for this <p><u>Pledges & Case Studies</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – EI discussed pledges received – just over 50 – Case studies received approx. 6 – All pledges will be submitted to NHSE with our ambition 	<p>1</p> <p>2</p>
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<p>4</p>	<p>Changing Systems - Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - EI met with the new Mayor within the VRU team, interested in early years and the system mapping that we are doing and seeing the results - SN and MC updated on changing systems work - Had meetings in all 5 areas - Leeds up and running Lucy White coordinating - Bradford up and running – Jo Howes - Kirklees – Rebecca Elliot - Wakefield – MC had meeting with Kerry Seaston, meeting on Friday with Denise Wheatman - Calderdale – in progress - Follow up names and areas around peer research – ongoing - Liaison and diversion research confirmed – barriers and what has worked - MC update on literature review - Contact from Susan Field looking at prisoners - Created 5 research questions to filter all info coming in - How do people make a life after trauma, what are the enabling factors – first question - This has led into looking at what training do people need in order to maximise chances of recovery and prevent re-traumatisation - Met with Gill Kelly to discuss data, This helped to answer the question of what has the impact of covid had on health inequalities and ways we can work with this group - Looked at future in mind plans and VRU reports, out of this – staffing dependant on time limited funding, finding the right staff challenging 	
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5	<p>Adversity, Trauma and Resilience – Community Action Collective</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - CR updated on where we are at over the past year - Importance of coproducing the strategy and language etc - Now want to look at doing something with communities as the event was for professionals - Last meeting agreed to establish Community Action Collective - Proposing bringing together organisations that already work with people with lived experience, already have relationships with community members, utilising expertise - Call out across all our organisations, across West Yorkshire, voluntary sector, statutory service - who would like to be part of this collective to coproduce work going forward – lived experience contributing to strategy - If engagement work or insight work has already taken place, to use this rather than duplicating work. - EI shared draft Crest report - Commissioned Crest through the ICS and the Violence Reduction Unit - piece of work to look at inequalities and depravation in relation to serious violence - Three cohorts 16-20 age, how economic instability could impact - Covid influence on trauma - Young women and girls – trigger factors - Links with the work with st Giles looking at young women and girls in the justice system – help to inform prevention and early intervention - EI discussed the Crest inequalities and serious violence in West Yorkshire report - All evidence based - How can members support this approach - Good timescales, enables to tap into existing resources - Volunteers to help pull this group together? - Consideration of the voices of those who struggle to engage - Street support teams 	3 - 4
