EI advised the group that she has asked somebody to present on some poverty research at this meeting but unfortunately they were unavailable but agreed to present at a future meeting.

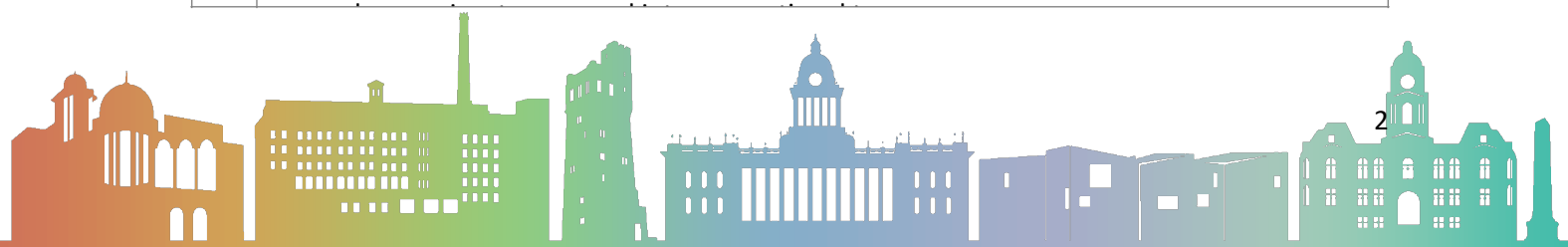
EI advised that she would be presenting today along with Cath Knibbs who leads on the Digital and Online Harms Workstream for the ATR programme.

3.	<p>What can we do at system? What can we do at place? What support and resources are available? EI asked the group the above questions.</p> <p>CB advised that at the University of Bradford she is working with young people and digital technology solutions for suicide prevention. A key message they are saying is if they go online, they want to stay online and not signposted to ringing someone or go to a website, they prefer a qualified person on chat. CK added that the 'person' is normally a 'bot' and young people are able to recognise this.</p> <p>SF advised that there is a lack of funding for young people, e.g. CAMHS which has an impact.</p>
