
# Trauma Informed Organisation 3 Levels Framework



- Providing service wide Trauma awareness
- Safety for all.



- Sensitive responses avoiding re-traumatisation.
- Addressing toxic stress and vicarious trauma.

# **Key Organisational Trauma Informed Messaging**



Trauma is an event, a series of events, or a set of circumstances that is experienced by an individual as physically or emotionally harmful or life threatening, that overwhelms a person's ability to cope and has lasting effects of mental physical, social, emotional or spiritual well-being"

(SAMSHA, 2014, p.7)

# How relevant is adversity to our population?






Source: Public Health Intelligence in Joint Strategic Needs Assessment: The Population of Bradford District

- 4th highest proportion of under 16s in England.
- 153 languages spoken by children in the district.
- More than one in three children live in poverty
- Highest crime rate in West Yorkshire (2019)
- Higher physical, emotional and sexual abuse of children than the rest of Yorkshire and England.
- 10,000 reports of DV to the police (2009-2010)
- 54% of serious sexual assaults committed by a woman's current or former partner





Average 0-10 score from evaluation questions where 0 = not informative/useful at all and 10 =extremely informative/useful (1,842 responses)



**72%** of all BDCFT staff completed the e-learning in the first 6months = 2016 people!








#### What word describes your reaction to watching the Resilience documentary?





