	<b>Welcome and Introductions</b>

3.	<b>Findings of the Education Insight Work</b> LC advised the group that the research had now finished and LC shared the findings. EI advised that we need to carry out some mapping across all of the education Settings to ascertain what already exists. This is about building on the good practice that already exists.</p> <p>EI added that we are embedding an evaluator, Rocket Science, who can, if the group wanted, provide a bespoke piece of evaluation/deep dive.</p> <p>EI felt that it would be beneficial for the virtual heads to provide a session at a future meeting and suggested that EI/CR/CA meeting with them first to discuss.</p> <p>CD advised that she is currently supporting Bradford College and agreed to provide an update at the next meeting.</p>
