language and training were the key areas.		
LC advised that she is able to provide basic trauma informed training in schools but		
would need to check with Carrie and Emm.		
RB asked the group if they were aware of The Difference Project and suggested		
that we link with them. LC advised that we would need to ask Carrie and Emm.		
AW advised that there were two documents for consultation by the DFE and in		
respect of behaviour and exclusions, they still uphold reward and sanctions but		
Wakefield is responding to this with the trauma informed research. LC offered her		
Support with the response to the DFE.		
BW suggested that parents/carers of looked after children need to be involved and		
need to understand the language.

LC advised the group that she is 1½ months into the project and has spoken to all		
virtual schools and would like to have a 'spotlight' on one school from each area.		
LC advised that the quality of the responses to the survey was good but she didn't
