

WY-FI Plus

WY-FI + is a community partnership supporting vulnerable adults in the Wakefield district to improve their health and wellbeing. Our partnership has two key elements: an Inclusive Healthcare Service and WY-FI.

Inclusive Healthcare Service

This is a tailored support service for adults who are currently homeless or rough sleeping. Through this, we offer:

- Focused, 1:1 Navigator support for homeless adults
- Signposting to support agencies, including community kitchens and charities
- Healthcare assessments and Health
 education

WY-FI

WY-FI is a navigation service which helps vulnerable people to get support when they need it most. We work with adults with multiple and complex needs who are struggling to access important services (such as healthcare or housing) and experiencing at least three of these risk factors:

- Homelessness
- Reoffending or contact with the criminal
- justice system
- Mental ill health
- Addiction (drug or alcohol problems)
- Domestic Abuse

Our Navigator model

Services are provided by team of Navigators, who work on a 1:1 basis to understand each client's situation and build up a trusting relationship.
